## Unit preparation information

Scouts / Venturers: Join us on February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025 on our Legend of the Yeti Klondike Derby. Come test your winter outdoor scout skills, teamwork and Yeti Lore. 10 great events are planned around these areas:

- Fire Building
- Knots / Lashings
- Patrol Method / Teambuilding
- Puzzling
- Orienteering
- Range & Target Activities
- Sled Racing

The committee has been busy planning a great event for your enjoyment. A full unit participation guide is anticipated to be available the week of January 13<sup>th</sup>. This will include a complete list of required sled items.

New for this year will be lunch on the trail. Each scout will need to prepare and bring along a foil pack for their lunch. Each patrol will supply a small (8-12 lb.) bag of charcoal at their first event, and a hot bed of coals will be ready for them when they complete the 4<sup>th</sup> station at lunch time.

We also have some extra activities at the stations for scouts to have some fun in the event they complete the rotation early.

As a reminder, this is a single-day event. If your unit would like to camp overnight, please reserve a campsite through the normal weekend rental system at [minsitrails.org](http://minsitrails.org).

Scouters: We are in need of volunteers to supervise and to help at event stations. We're anticipating needing 80 volunteers.
