This fall, Minsi Trails Council invites Scouts to Camp Minsi for a weekend where ropes, spars, teamwork, and ingenuity take center stage. Patrols will face a series of pioneering challenges designed to test more than just their knowledge of knots and lashings. Scouts will need to plan, communicate, solve problems, and work together to turn a pile of spars and rope into something that gets the job done. Whether you're an experienced pioneering crew or still figuring out the difference between a square lashing and a shear lashing, there will be challenges, opportunities to learn, and plenty of chances to put your skills into action.

**Things to remember to bring:** Scouts should be prepared to sleep in tents. Bring along standard camping equipment for the weekend: sleeping bag, mess kit, water bottle, flashlight, first aid kit, compass, day pack, camp chair, weather appropriate clothing for the weekend's weather, rain gear, and proper shoes. Please bring an extra change of clothes and a pair of shoes in case you get wet. Remember, this is Fall camping and any type of weather can be expected so plan accordingly.
