

CANOEING CAMPOUT



**FRIDAY, JUNE 12 TO
SATURDAY, JUNE 13, 2026**

Come join us for two fun and relaxing days canoeing **23 miles down the Delaware River**. No experience necessary. Space is limited to 12 participants for this trip due to the number of Troop canoes. Scouts will have priority. This trip will include canoeing on the Delaware River, camping, fishing, and provide a great opportunity to learn how to handle a canoe on some easy flowing water.

Permission Form and \$12 payment due by Monday, June 1, 2026.

Bring a bag lunch and snacks for Friday afternoon. Dinner Friday night, along with Saturday and Sunday's meals, will be provided.

We will meet at Camp Spirit on Friday morning, **6/12/26, at 7 am**, load up and depart for the Delaware River by 8 Am. We will load into the river at Sandts Eddy Boat Ramp, 4807 S Delaware Dr., Easton PA. We'll canoe 10 miles downstream past Easton where we will spend the night on Whippoorwill Island in Williams Twsp. Saturday morning we will break camp, paddle 13 miles and finish our adventure, pulling out of the river at Pursell's Landing, across from 1496 River Rd, Upper Black Eddy. We expect to **return to Camp Spirit around 3 or 4 pm Saturday.**


What to bring:


- Bagged Lunch for Friday
- Water bottle
- Swimwear
- Close-toed water shoes (no flip flops, Crocs discouraged)
- Wide Brimmed Hat
- Tent (personal or Troop)
- Ground cloth / tarp
- Sleeping bag or blanket
- Sleepwear
- Rain gear
- Flashlight
- Bug spray (non-aerosol)
- Sunscreen
- Beach towel
- Toiletries
- Fishing pole and tackle (optional)
- Extra bungee cords or cordage to secure your gear to the canoe (optional)

Reminder: We are only camping one night so your large camp totes are not necessary. Try and pack light, similar to an overnight hike but in a soft, waterproof duffle bag (or soft duffle lined with a plastic bag) to help save room in the canoe for our other essential campsite gear.

If you would like to use your own canoe or kayak and can transport it to and from the outing, please contact Mr. Palumbo. This will allow additional scouts to attend. No paddle boards, please.
