



Troop 72 Game Lands Spring Service Project


General Cleanup

Sunday, April 19, 2026: 1:00 – 3:00 PM

- Come join Troop 72's annual service project at the PA State Game Lands off Route 100. This will be a general cleanup as we have done in the past to help our local community. This will be our 30th year with the PA Game Commission.
- We will need help from leaders and parents to transport Scouts around to the various locations within the Game Lands.
- Please wear appropriate clothing – long pants, long sleeve shirt, and work gloves. The work should take 2 hours or less. Scouts – this work counts as service time for rank advancement, including conservation service for Life Rank.
- **Meet at 1:00 PM at the first parking lot on the left side of Warden Road before the shotgun range** (do not go to Camp Spirit). Directions and a map are included below:

Directions to Game Lands:

Take Route 100 north from Mohr Lane for 5 miles. Just past the entrance to the KOA and crossing Jordan Creek, make a sharp right onto Sell Rd. When Sell Rd. bears left and goes uphill, stay to the right on Warden Rd, along the bank of Jordan Creek. Warden Rd. will go uphill, and wind around a bit. The parking lot is on the left when the road straightens out again.
