Friday August 7: Meet at Camp Spirit promptly at 10:00 AM. Departure will be by 10:30 AM.

- Pack a lunch to bring with you on Friday.
- Arrival at Bass River State Forest will be about 2:00 PM. Set up camp, visit the lake at the campground and prepare dinner at the camp site.
- Friday evening, we will go to the Seaside Heights Boardwalk. Scouts – bring extra spending money for food, games, and souvenirs.
- Saturday morning, breakfast at campsite then off to beach at Ship Bottom, Long Beach Island for the day.
- Saturday evening, dinner will be at the campsite, evening campfire.
- Sunday, Scout's Own service at campsite, pack up camp, and departure.

Sunday August 9: Return to Camp Spirit approximately 1:00 PM.

What to bring: Lunch for drive to Bass River State Park, Camp Spirit Class "B" Red or Green shirts, (no Class "A" needed), Tent (personal or Troop), ground cloth, sleeping bag, rain gear, flashlight, bug spray (non-aerosol), swim gear, sunscreen, beach towel, beach chair, beach footwear, boogie board, beach games/toys, spending money (boardwalk), mess kit. **Reminder, we are only going for the weekend, so your large camp totes are not necessary. Try to bring a soft duffle bag to help save room in the trailer for our other essential site camp gear.**
