The weekend is for instruction and discussion on wilderness survival. Learn the arts of survival to live with only the bare essentials. A scout can fulfill some of the requirements for the merit badge over the course of the weekend, pre-event preparation will be required, assemble survival kit.. You will be given food for cooking (You won't starve). This will be done with the minimum of cooking utensils. Shelters will need to be constructed during the day and sleep in them Saturday evening. This will be a rain or shine event. Instruction and shelter building will be done at Camp Spirit. This will also include events for the Camp Spirit Survivor Award.

The main thing is to remember **BE PREPARED.**
